Steve was born in Nottinghamshire in 1947 and educated at a local Grammar School and at Grey College, Durham University. On leaving Durham in 1969, Steve joined C & A (an international clothing retail group) for whom he worked until his early retirement in March 2004. He worked in many areas of the business from store management and buying administration to systems development and support in the UK, Belgium and Germany. In retirement, Steve became a Trustee and volunteer at Grey College and at the Museum of English Rural Life in Reading, where he and his family lived for over 35 years. When he and his wife Jacky came to Swindon, Steve became a volunteer in the Library/ Archive at STEAM in January 2007, taking on a role as Trustee of the Friends of Swindon Railway Museum four years later.

In 2015, Steve was invited to represent the Friends and volunteers in the project which carried out an in-depth review of the governance model for STEAM and assessed possible future options.

He is keen to help develop the Friends' fundraising activities, approaching local and national organisations where appropriate.
